Description and Purpose of Event: Tie Dye-versity

 We are in the process of planning a tie dye event, where the main component is focusing on diversity. Using different colors of the dye, a social identity worksheet, and discussion questions, we intend on creating a space where residents can engage with one another in dialogue across differences. We believe this program will create opportunities for residents to not only build community, but to learn about one another. We think this is especially important for North Quad as it is home to the Max Kade German Residence learning community, the Global Scholars Program learning community, and the International Impact Theme community. This diverse group of students can build connections that we believe our program can be the platform for.

Role of Purchase in Event: The shirts are the main material for the event.

• Additional materials we will be purchasing using our budget include: fabric dye, rubber bands, ziploc bags, gloves, and tarps (for protecting the space) - which we estimate to cost around \$250.

Additional Information/Justification: In our Hall Council Meetings, we have spoken with floor representatives who highlight that building shirts would build community. However, due to the cost of the shirts and our small budget (\$2800), we wanted the purchase to be more purposeful than a simple tie-dye event and came up with "Tie Dye-versity."

In working with Underground Printing, we asked for the most inexpensive long-sleeved shirts they had available. We wanted to use long-sleeved shirts as this program will occur in December and residents will be wearing it throughout the colder months.

We surveyed the North Quad community if they would be interested in this program if they were receiving a free t-shirt and we received an overwhelming response of 222, where 132 said "yes" and 75 said "maybe." This response rate is about half of our building size. In the same survey, we have also collected shirt size information and design voting from resident submissions. We received two submissions (seen below) and they have both been approved by Anneke Darling, Program Manager for Student Leadership.

We want to put both designs on the shirt as they show both angles of North Quad and thought it would be a nice visual representation when residents wear the shirts.
